

- Interactive session with Bijoy Ramachandran, anchor of this program, and a few invited Bengaluru architects.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

DAY-1

Arrive and check-in to hotel on prior day

We head out on the first day to the iconic IIMB main campus and visit the institution's new campus with Sanjay Mohe from Mindspace, the architects. As part of these visits we will have access to the main academic buildings and the resource people will make presentations on the history of this important institution and its architectural & landscape heritage. We will also visit A Threshold's widely published and awarded project, Subterranean Ruins. This young practice won the Architectural Review's Emerging Prize this year. G. Reghu, the celebrated sculptor lives close by and we will drop in to see his studio and work.

He currently serves on the faculty of architecture at the British School at Rome and is the Design Chair for the post-graduate program at BMS College of Architecture in Bengaluru.

Ramachandran has a Master's degree in Architecture and Urbanism from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and a Bachelor's degree from BMS College of Architecture; he has also attended the Glenn Murcutt masterclass in Sydney.

In addition to practicing architecture, he has also produced three documentary films: two on the celebrated Indian architect Sri B.V. Doshi, 'Doshi' (2008) and 'Doshi: The Second Chapter' (2019); and one on architectural practice in Bangalore, 'Architecture and the City: A Bangalore Perspective' (2005).

Who Should Apply?	The program is designed for Architects and other design professionals, real estate and planning professionals, design enthusiasts.
Program Fee	INR 56,000/- + GST This is inclusive of local travel to the sites in a shared AC vehicle, and this is exclusive of lodging and boarding. An early bird discount of INR 6,000/- on the abovementioned fee is available till 15th January 2025. A discount of INR 5,000/- is available for CEPT Alumni.
Certificate	Participants will receive a certificate from CEPT University on successful completion of the program with a minimum of 80 percent attendance.
